



EMT COURSE INFORMATION
APS Ambulance offers this course
at Northland Career Center

Starts: Monday, August 29, 2016

Meets: Mondays and Wednesdays, 6:00-10:00 p.m. for 35 sessions, including five 5-hour classes Saturday Sept. 17, Oct. 1 & 23, Nov. 12 & Dec. 17 at APS Ambulance. **No class on Sept. 5, Oct. 10, 24 & 31, Nov. 23 & Dec. 19.** Final class is Dec. 21, 2016. There may also be some makeup classes when school is called due to weather.

Cost: \$900.00 (Includes text and work book, clinical fees, clinical t-shirt and name tag)

Payment: \$100.00 Non-Refundable Registration Fee due upon enrollment. If entire balance of \$900.00 is not paid by first night of class, students must meet with Lisa Weatherly, Director of Adult and Community Education and complete a Payment Agreement Form. Then \$400 is due first night of class and remaining balance of \$400 is due on Oct. 5, 2016.

Licensure: Upon completion of the course, instructors will help students schedule their National Registry Exam. The Practical Exam and National Registry written test fees are **not included** in program cost. Estimated cost of these exams is \$140.00.
