## DAILY WELLNESS CHECK

Before leaving for work or sending a student to school, conduct a wellness check to ensure good health. If you or anyone in your home is ill, please stay home. You can find a link to the [Daily Wellness Check](#) on the District website homepage.

## GEAR

Don't forget your face covering and refillable water bottle labeled with your name. Bring your backpack, fully-charged Chromebook (Grades 6-12), and lunch or lunch money. PreK-5th graders will receive a lanyard for keeping face coverings handy. 6th grade "A" learners will receive their devices on the first day of school. 6th grade learners on the "B" alternating schedule (with last names starting with L-Z) can pick up Chromebooks at the following times/locations.

- **Barry School:** September 3, 1-6pm, and September 4, 10am-4pm
- **Compass Elementary:** September 3, 1-6pm, and September 4, 10am-4pm

## ARRIVAL

Buildings will share their drop-off procedures and locations with families. Please ensure you arrive with your face covering on; students must also wear face coverings on the bus. Parents/guardians will not exit vehicles or accompany students into the building.

## PE/ATHLETICS/ FINE ARTS

6th-12th grade students are encouraged to come to school dressed for Physical Education class. Locker rooms will only be used in small cohort groups when physical distancing can be maintained. 6th-12th grade band students are being supplied with special instrument-playing face coverings. Coaches and fine arts teachers will communicate practice schedules and classroom guidelines.

## NAVIGATING

Staff will be stationed around the building helping students get to classes, find their way, and learn our new procedures for keeping everyone healthy.

## MEALS

Students may bring their own lunch or purchase from their [home school's menu](#). Elementary students will begin the year using an alternating schedule with half of classes eating lunch in the cafeteria and half eating in their classroom. On 6th-12th grade students' remote learning days, lunches can be ordered through [Nutrislice](#) by clicking on the Pickup tab or the SFE to Go link. Use your child's student ID number to create an account on Nutrislice. Orders must be placed no later than 9:30am the day of service and picked up curbside at the following times/locations:

- **Barry School:** Front circle drive, 1 to 1:30pm
- **Platte City Middle School (for PCMS and PCHS students):** Northside drive, 12:30 to 1:30 pm.

All free and reduced meal prices qualify, but orders must still be placed on Nutrislice.
