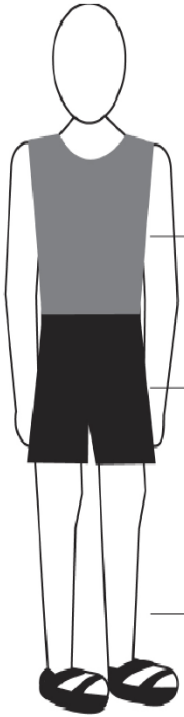


## STUDENT DRESS CODE AND APPEARANCE

Extremes in dress and personal appearance which tend to cause distraction, call undue attention to the wearer, or pose health or safety problems will not be allowed to be worn at school. **Students who chose to not follow these guidelines will be asked to change their clothing, cover up, or go home.**

The shaded portions of the figure below, illustrate the portions of the body that must be covered while attending school.



Clothing must cover undergarments, stomach, back and chest. No see-through apparel, muscle shirts, spaghetti straps or open back shirts.

Shorts, skirts and dresses must be the length of the student's finger tips when extended. No sagging.

Appropriate footwear must be worn at all times. House shoes/slippers are not acceptable footwear for school.

### Other Guidelines

- Clothing that promotes drugs, alcohol, violence, is sexually suggestive, or displays any picture or writing that may be perceived inappropriate is prohibited.
- No head gear is permitted during the school day. This includes but is not limited to hats, bandanas, sweatbands, caps, hair rollers, picks, combs and hoods.
- Any clothing worn in a manner identified as gang-related is prohibited.
- Jewelry that can pose a safety hazard is prohibited.
