Writing Behaviors				
Holds more complex ideas in memory while writing.				
Rereads to remember next idea; reflects on meaning, sentence structures and word choice.				
Analyzes unknown words quickly on the run.				
Breaks unknown words into syllables, onset, and rime, or at meaningful parts; uses common spelling patterns to spell words conventionally.				
Uses known words as a base for adding simple inflectional endings (s, ing, ed).				
Writes grade level high-frequency words fluently and accurately.				
Writing includes words that reflect attention to vocabulary and word meanings from reading.				
Uses planning page to try out crafting techniques (word choice, leads, endings, etc.)				
Applies appropriate standard English grammar.				
Applies appropriate conventions of standard English (capitalization and punctuation appropriately).
