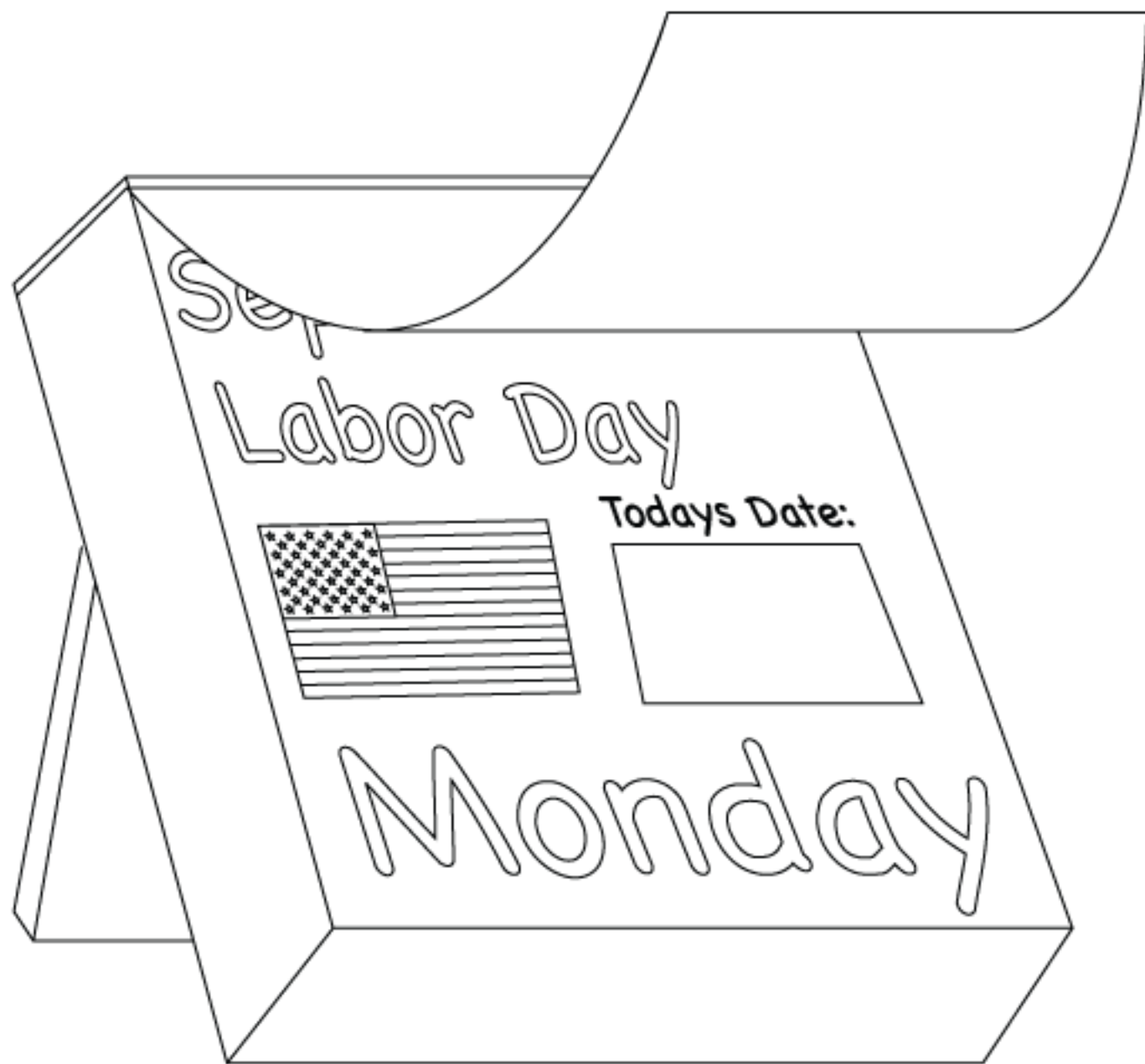

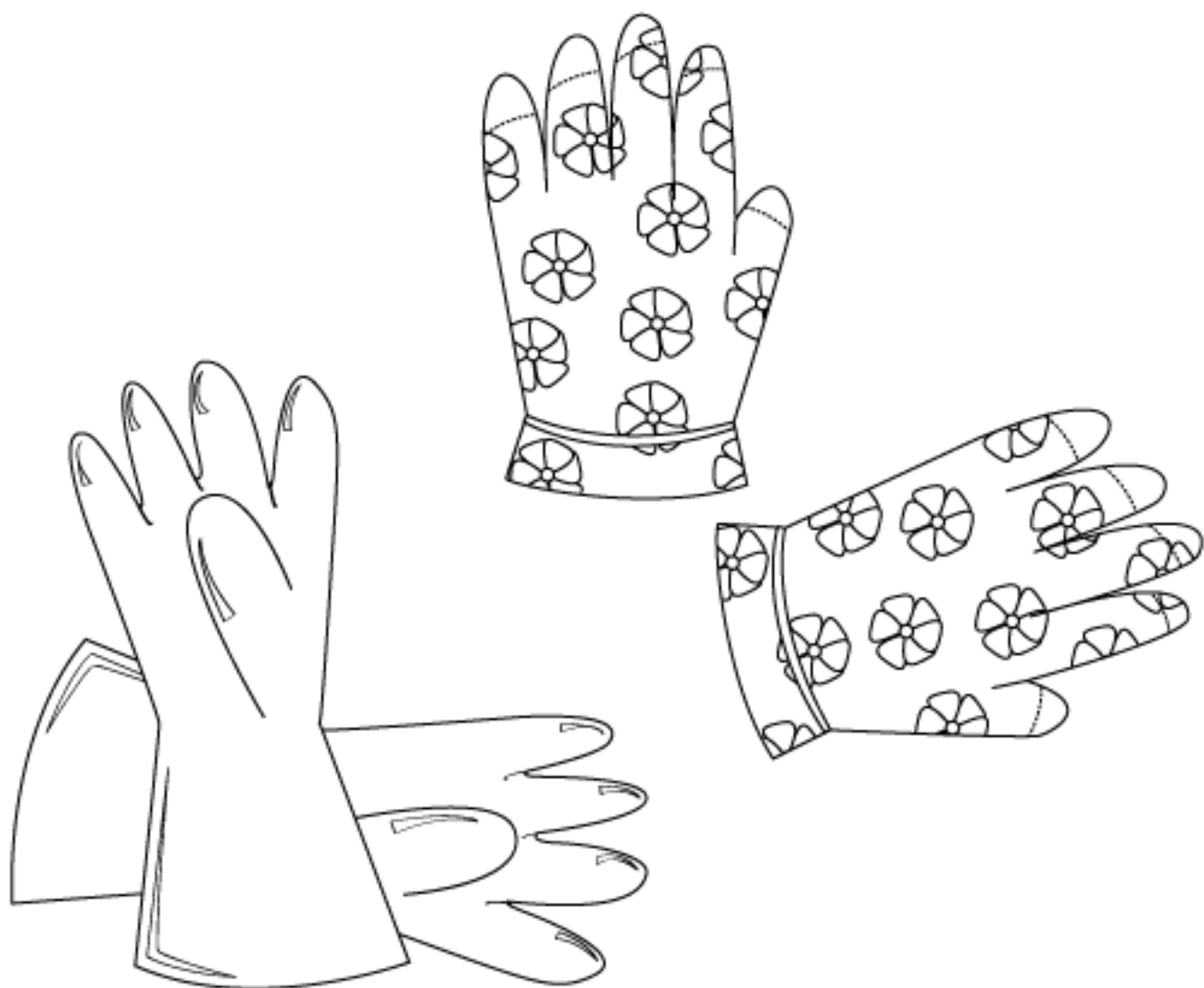

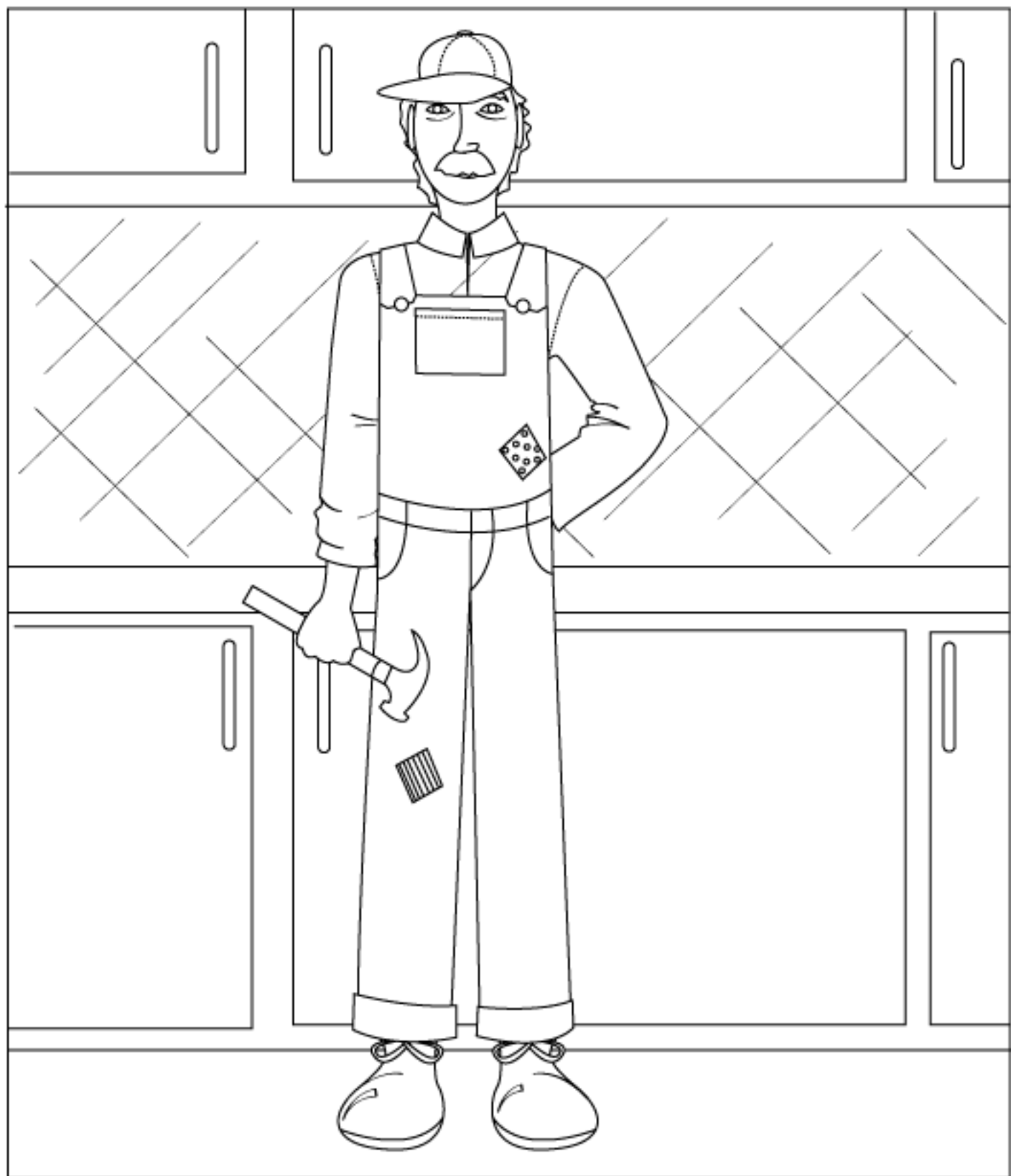


Labor Day is a holiday. It always falls on the first Monday of September.

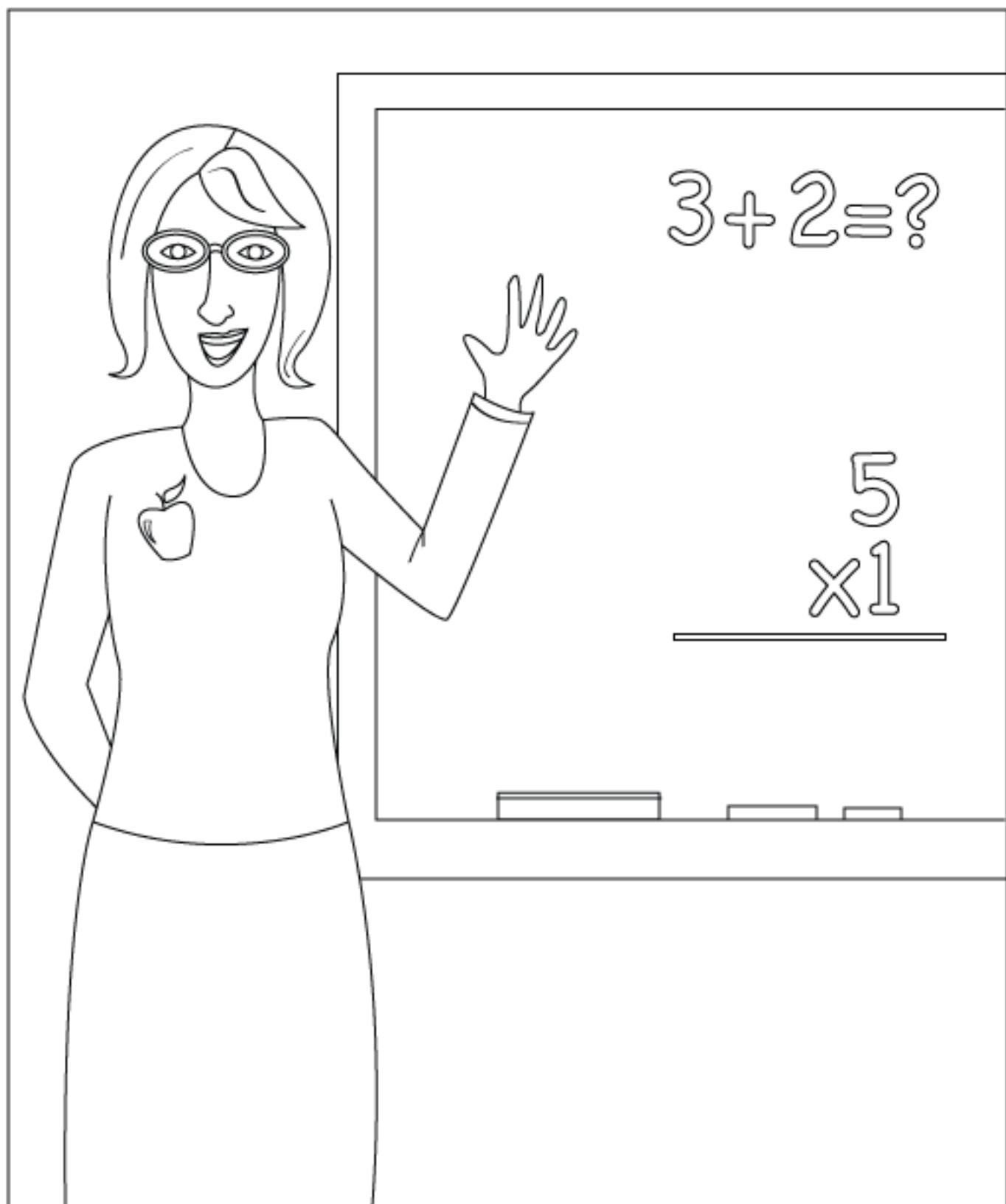
LABOR = WORK



Another word for *labor* is *work*.



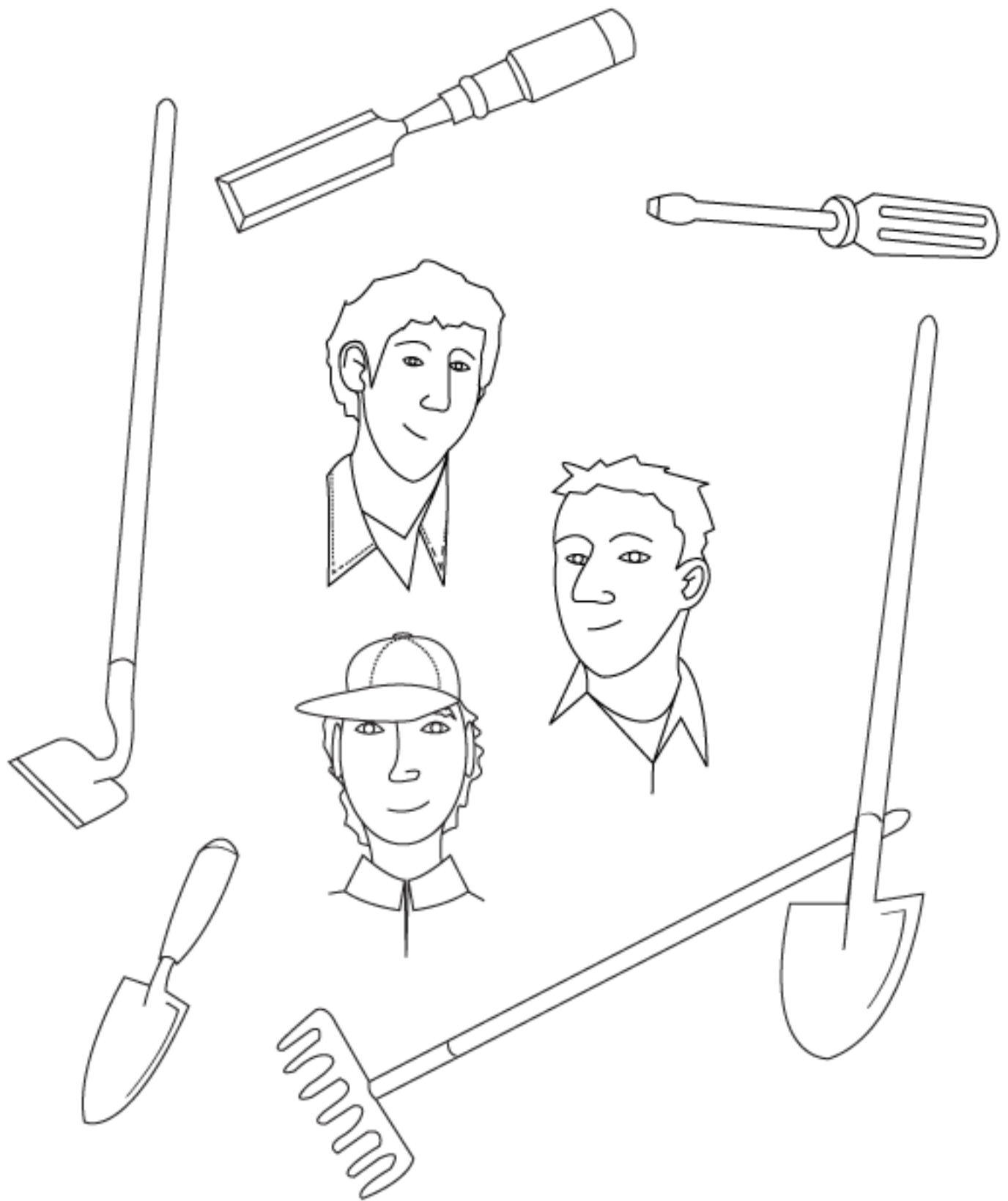
Matthew Maguire thought people who work should have their own holiday. He is called the “Father of Labor Day.”



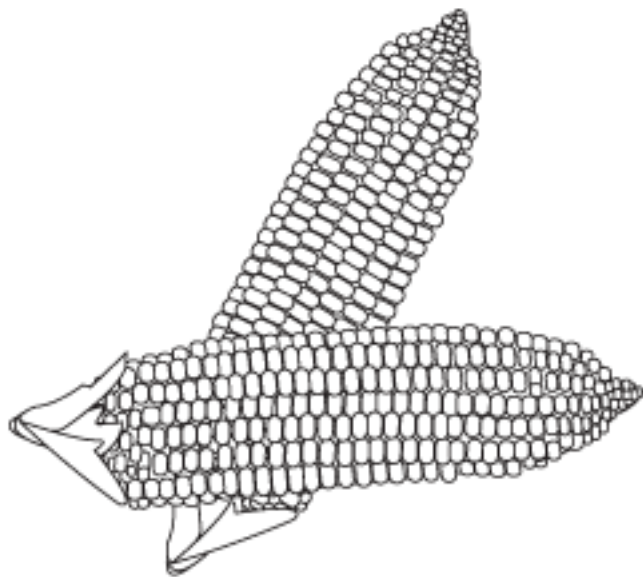
On Labor Day, we think of our teachers.



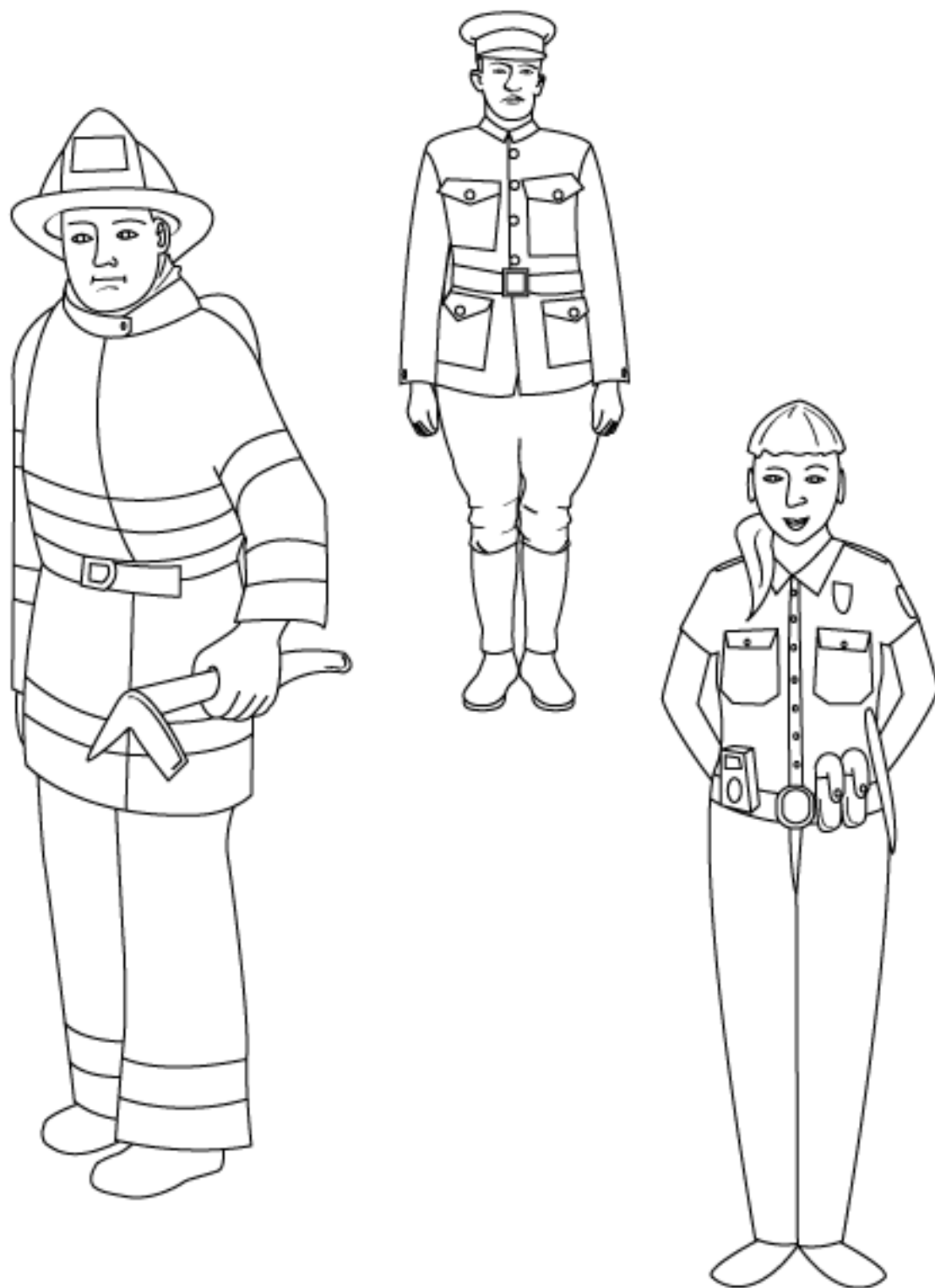
We think of our doctors.



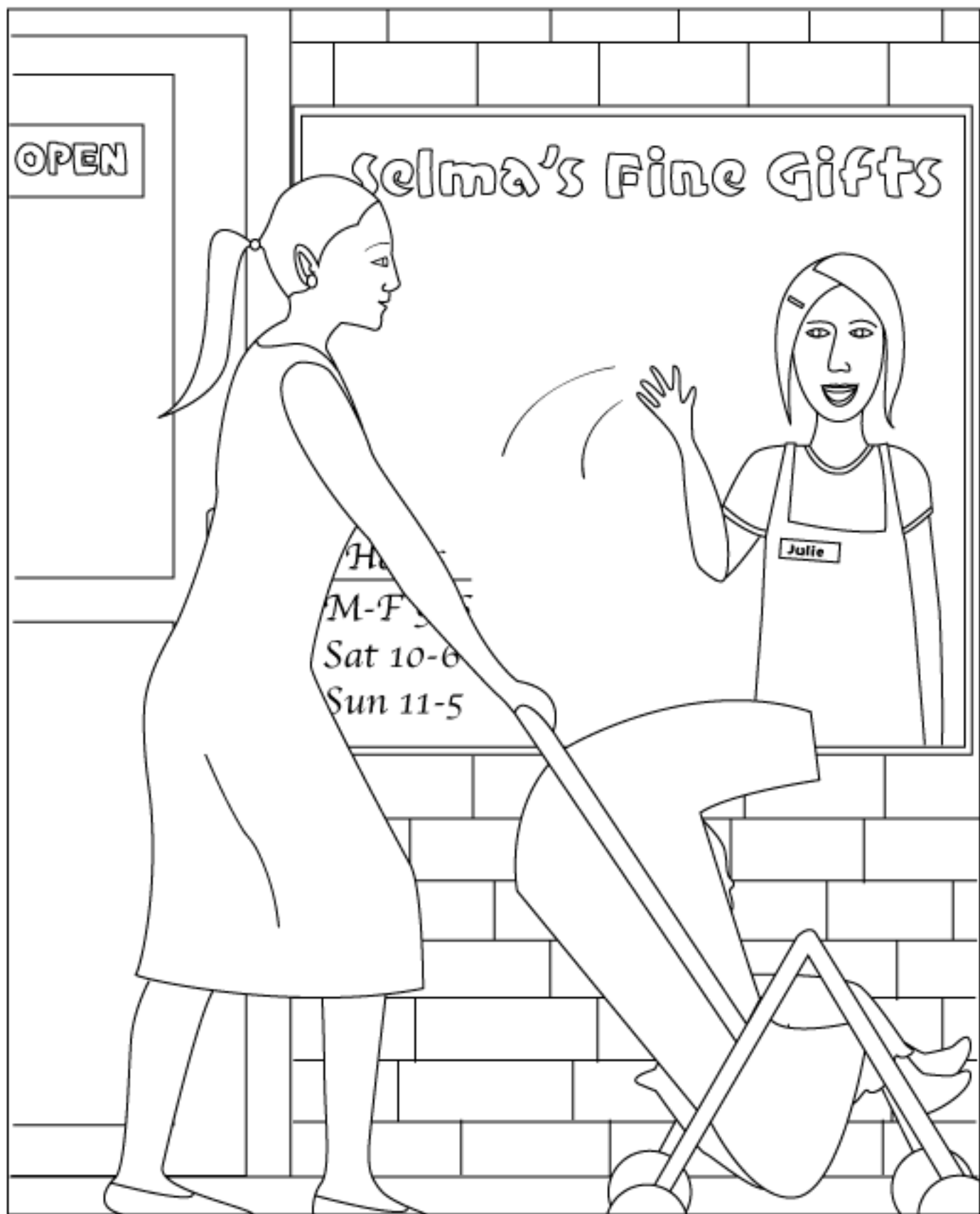
We think of the people who build houses and roads.

and make the clothes we wear.

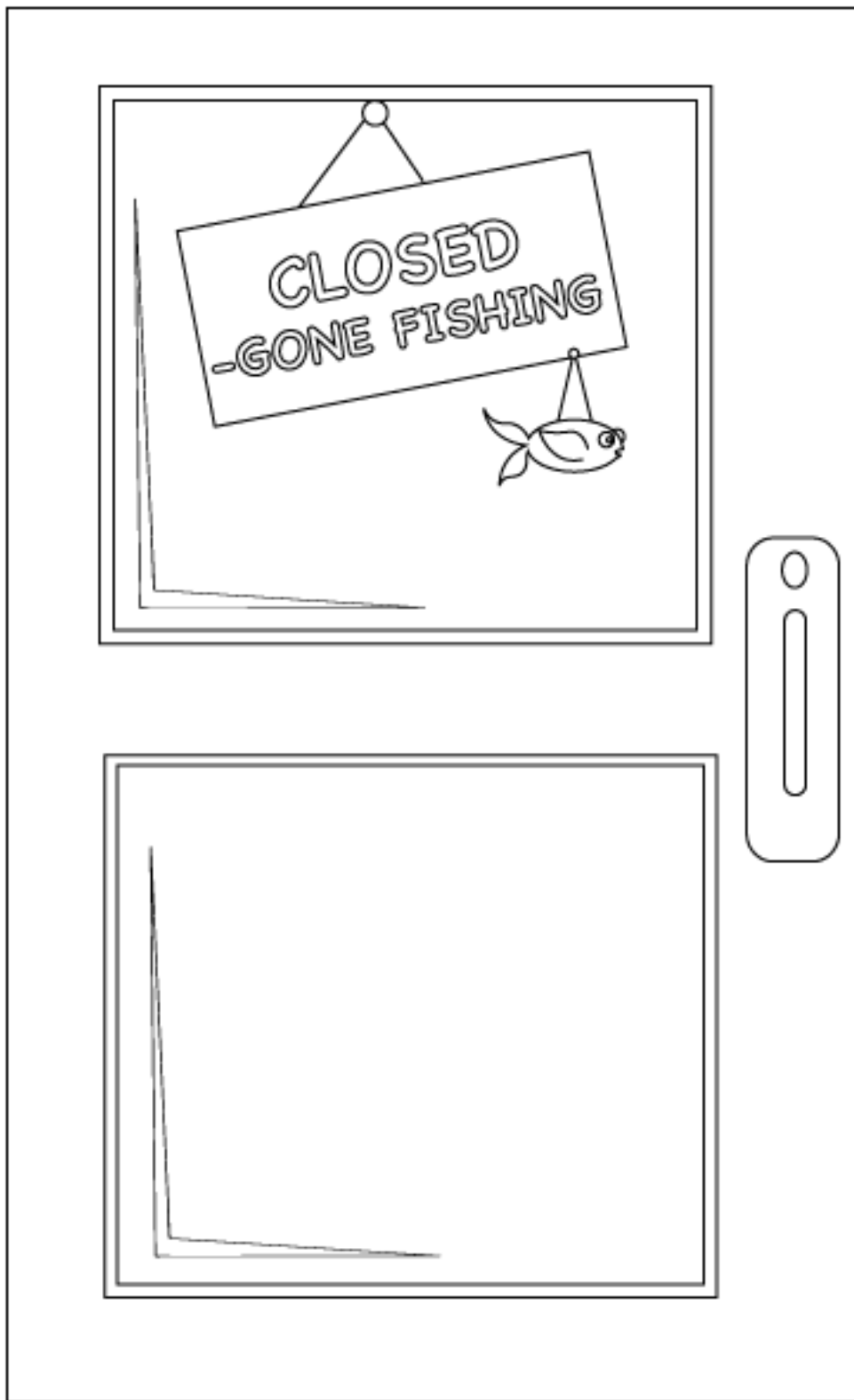


We think of the people who fight crime. We think of those who fight fires. We think of those who fight for our freedom.
