The ACT is the leading U.S. college admissions test measuring what you learn in high school to determine your academic readiness for college. It is a multiple-choice, pencil-and-paper test administered by ACT, Inc.

The required portion of the test is divided into four multiple choice subject tests: English, mathematics, reading, and science reasoning. Subject test scores range from 1-36. ACT with Writing is the optional test. Most coastal schools require the test With Writing.
